Title I is a federally funded program that provides financial support to schools based on the number of enrolled students from low-income families. The goal of this funding is to ensure that all students, regardless of background, have access to a high-quality education and are able to meet state academic standards.

At Hilltown, we use our Title I funds to help place a second adult in every classroom. This additional support allows us to lower the student-to-adult ratio, making it easier to provide personalized instruction, targeted interventions, and greater support for all learners. Our teaching assistants work closely with classroom teachers, interventionists, and special education teachers as part of a collaborative process.

By investing in more hands-on support in each classroom, we are able to create a more inclusive, responsive learning environment, especially for students who may need extra help to meet grade-level expectations.
